
Prof. PLO Lumumba pays courtesy call to Zetech University

This groundbreaking prototype was developed by three ambitious students: Samuel Oduor and Elizabeth Onyango, both pursuing Bachelor of Science in Information Technology in their third year, along with Isaac Muendo, currently in his final year of Diploma in Computer Science.



The Smart Pest Deterrent System provides a robust solution for safeguarding crops during the critical harvest season. Its key features include real-time monitoring with drones for early detection, AI-powered pest identification ensuring accuracy, targeted acoustic deterrents, and a smart scarecrow equipped with a camera for continuous surveillance.

Additionally, the system offers an online portal for farmer registration and easy access to services, enhancing usability and convenience. The innovative system incorporates a range of cutting-edge technologies to ensure comprehensive and efficient pest management.




From captivating keynotes to interactive panel sessions and skill-building workshops led by industry experts, the event was nothing short of transformative. It was inspiring and empowering.
